Students develop workplace and civic skills by volunteering and studying food insecurity in their community.

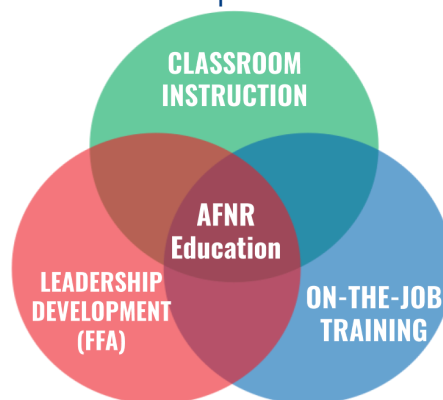
