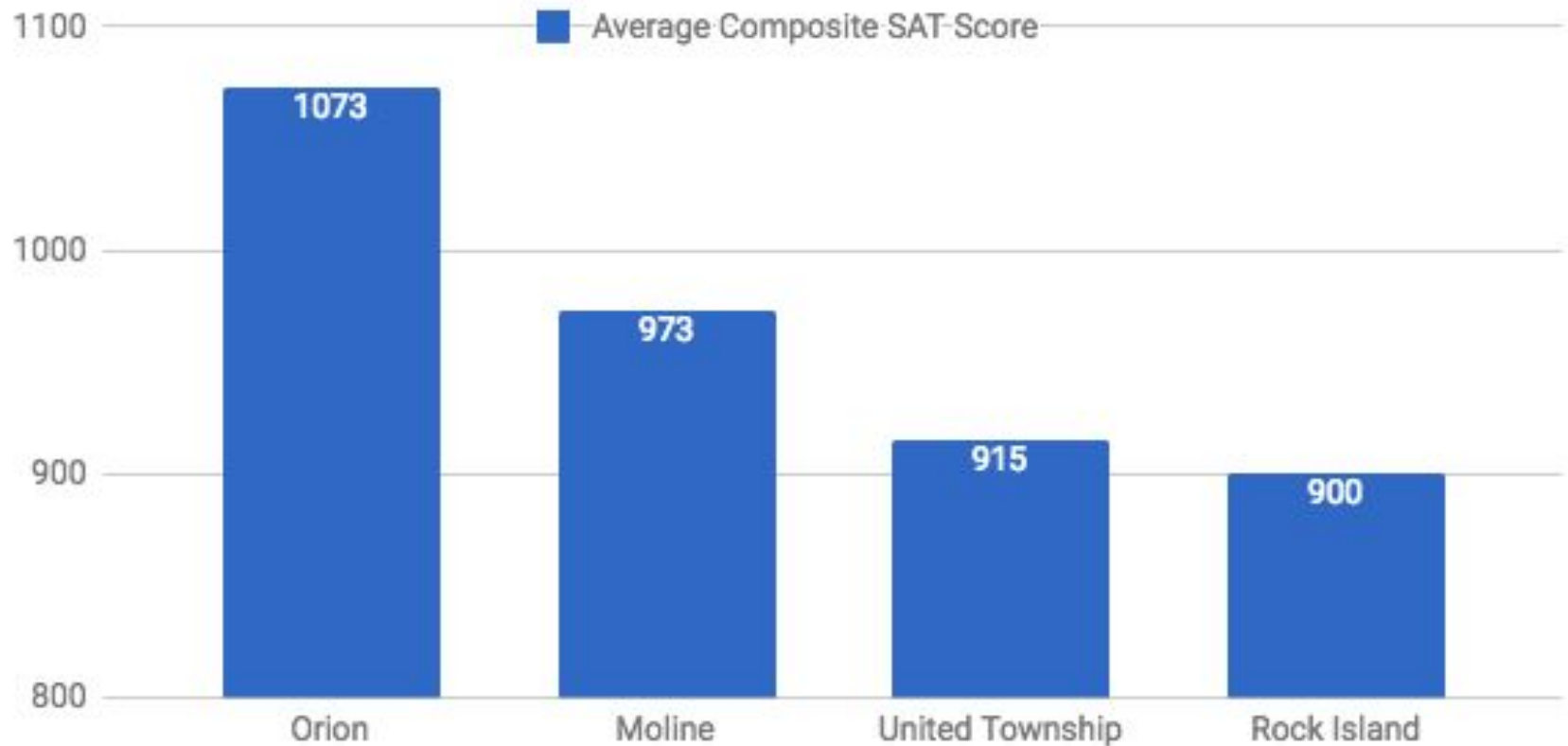

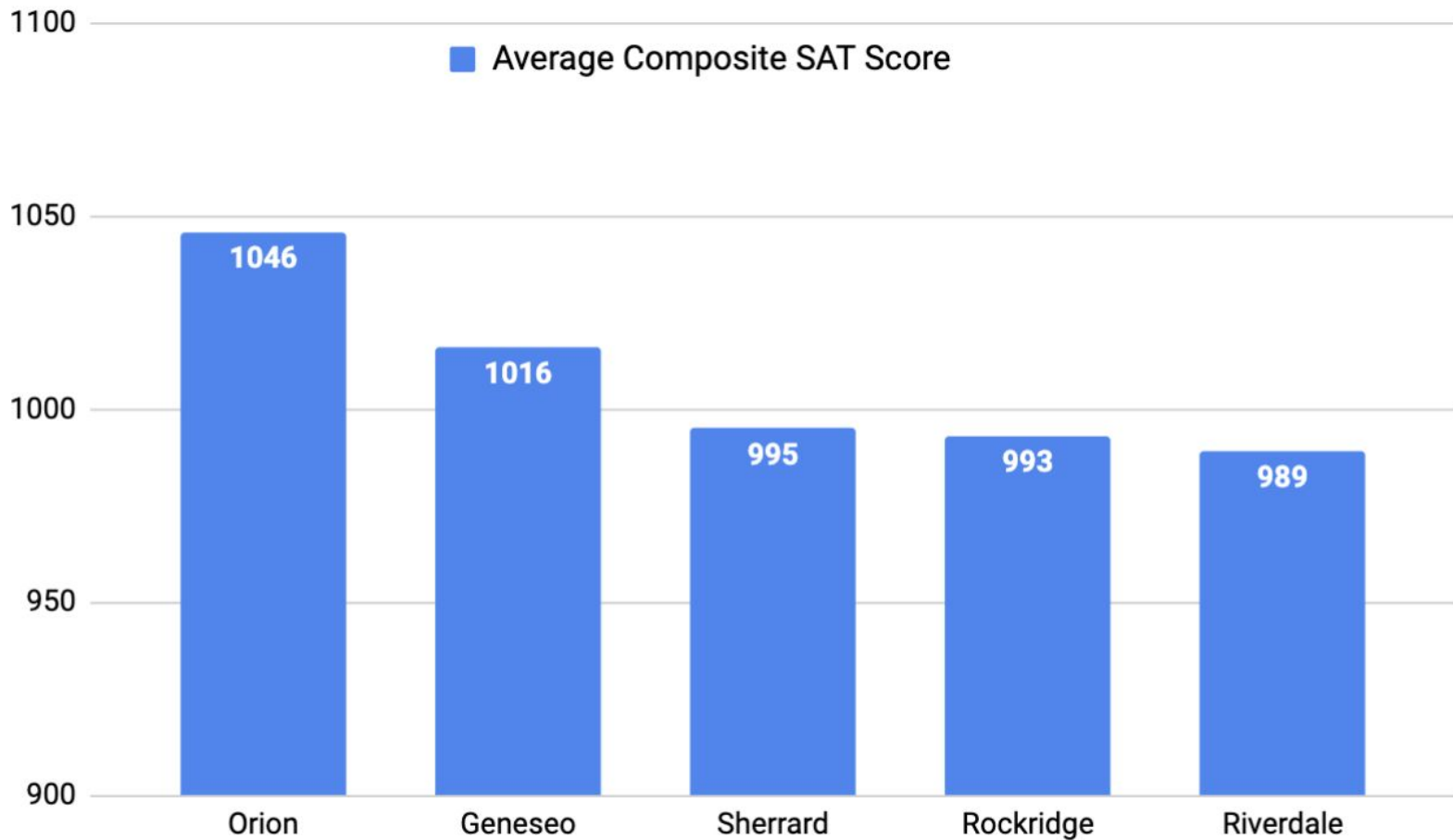
- Located 20 Minutes from the Quad Cities

SAT Scores – Orion vs. Smaller Schools within 20 miles of Downtown Moline



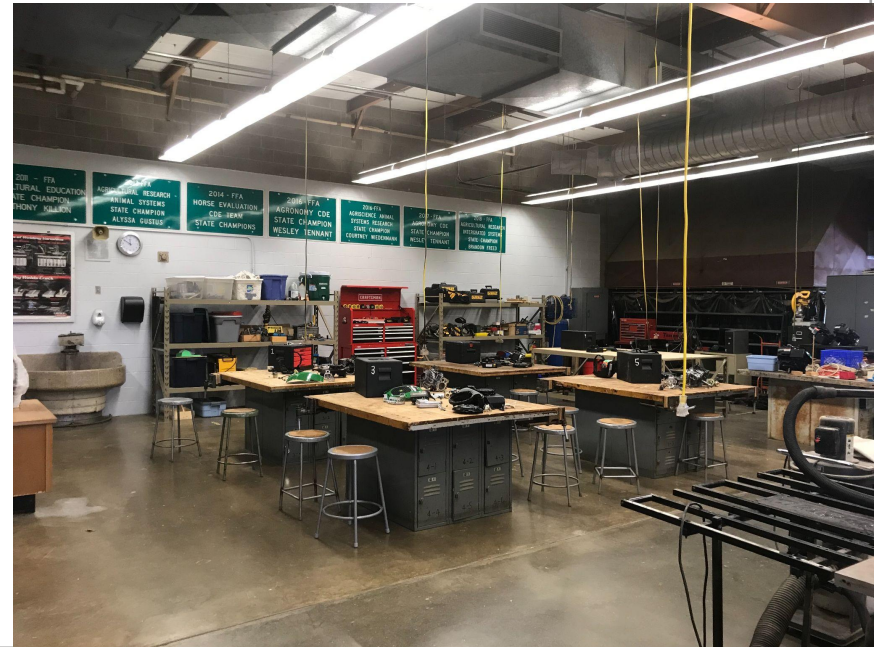
Orion Provides Additional Opportunities
