

Chapter President Award

Overview

PURPOSE

The purpose of this award is to recognize individuals who have excelled in their role as a FFA Chapter President.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must be an Illinois FFA member in good standing and be currently serving or have spent majority of the current school year serving as an FFA chapter president.

AWARD

All applicants will receive a gold, silver, or bronze rating and be recognized at the annual Illinois FFA Convention. The top 10 highest scoring applicants will also receive special recognition for their outstanding efforts as chapter presidents at the annual Illinois FFA Convention.

APPLICATION

A complete application package must be submitted to be eligible for consideration of this award.

A complete application package includes the completion of:

Section 1: Chapter Events (505 points)

- 5 Chapter event narratives at the chapter level - 305 points
- % of chapter members involved with the 5 events - 150 points
- Chapter meetings - 50 points

Section 2: Events Above the Chapter Level (250 points)

- 5 Chapter event narratives above the chapter level - 150 points
- % of chapter members involved with the 5 events - 50 points
- Other event participation above the chapter level - 50 points

Section 3: Supervised Agricultural Experience (100 points)

- State Degree - 25 points
- Proficiency participation/Star recognition - points vary based on level
- SAE promotion above the chapter level - points vary based on level

Section 4: National Chapter (50 points)

SELECTIONS

The selection committee will consist of members from the Illinois Farm Bureau Young Leader Committee. Award recipients will be notified by Illinois Farm Bureau via email from youth@ilfb.org.

SPONSORS
